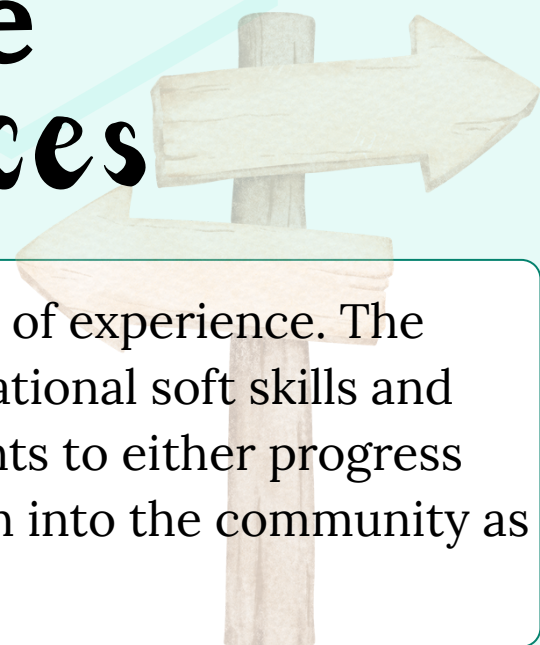


Careers Programme Encounters & Experiences
