### Pathway 4

Our 'Enhanced Transition' pathway is a bespoke offering that facilitates learners transition to full-time education or the workplace. Following an initial assessment period, subject input is planned to meet agreed outcomes.



### Pathway 1

Yr 12

**Examples of the curriculum content include:**

- Supported group work placement or enterprise activities from Easter for one day per week
- Problem Solving
- Team Work
- Following Instructions

Yr 13

**Examples of the curriculum content include:**

*\*relevant curriculum components from Year 12 will be revisited and revised as necessary*

- *Group work placements or individual supported placements from September for one or two days per week*
- *Developing communication skills*
- *Building confidence and self-esteem*
- *Personal presentation skills*
- *Decision making*

Yr 14

**Examples of the curriculum content include:**

*\*relevant curriculum components from Year 13 will be revisited and revised as necessary*

- *Group or individual supported work placements for students September onwards to include those students considered for transition beyond Year 14 for between 1 and 3 days per week*



Yr 12

**Examples of the curriculum content include:**

- Work placement offered from Easter, individual or group dependent upon individual needs of students, for one day per week
- Understand the skills and qualities needed for working life
- Investigate personal work opportunities
- Mini-enterprise projects
- Problem Solving
- Team Work
- Following Instructions

Yr 13

**Examples of the curriculum content include:**

*\*relevant curriculum components from Year 12 will be revisited and revised as necessary*

- *Existing work placement continues for one/day days per week where possible. If required, an alternative placement sourced.*
- *Communication skills for the workplace*
- *Building confidence and self-esteem*
- *Personal presentation skills*
- *Decision making*

Yr 14

**Examples of the curriculum content include:**

*\*relevant curriculum components from Year 13 will be revisited and revised as necessary*

- *Where possible, work placement increases to 3 days per week. Employer liaison to explore paid employment options.*
- *Applying knowledge and skills developed during Year 12 and 13 in a range of practical contexts, and with increased levels of independence.*

- Independent work placement offered from Easter, one day per week
- Planning for Progression
- Effective Communication

*\*relevant curriculum components from Year 12 will be revisited and revised as appropriate*

- Independent work placement continues for one/two days per week. .  
*If required, an alternative placement sourced.*
- Searching for a Job
- Applying for a Job
- Interview Skills

Yr 14

**Examples of the curriculum content include:**

*\*relevant curriculum components from Year 13 will be revisited and revised as appropriate*

- *Independent work placement continues for 3 days per week where possible. Employer liaison to explore paid employment/apprenticeship options*
- Working towards individual goals to support successful progression to each student's intended destination.
