Rather than teach English as a separate subject, opportunities to develop English skills are embedded across the curriculum. A student's starting point for speaking and listening, reading and writing is determined by students' prior attainment and initial assessment; assessment feedback is utilised to inform the appropriate level of skill to embed within lessons. Individualised maths targets and/or outcomes are also worked towards during structured 'personalised learning' sessions.
